Regulations

The GMS regulations schedule 6, part 2 and PMS regulations schedule 5, part 2 allow for a contractor to apply to NHS England to close their list. Amendments to the regulations were made in April 2012 which provided a clearer, more detailed process to ensure applications for list closure were applied more consistently.

Practice application

The practice application has included the following information:-

- The practice have requested for the temporary list closure due to increasing work arising from new patients combined with existing patients which is increasing the clinical demands tremendously. As the practice is single handed it is felt that there are time constraints in providing and giving adequate time and care to every patient as well as the inability to attend developmental meetings and organizational work.
- The Practice have considered taking on a new Partner but financially this is not viable with a list size of 2,400 patients. The impact of neighbouring practices closing their lists has been felt by the practice.
- The patients have not formally been consulted with however there have been concerns raised from the patients when appointment availability has not been met due to time constraints.
- The practice would welcome any clinical support from NHS England in light of the fact the practice is single handed and there are financial limitations.

• The practice has a varying population requiring different types of Pathology it is hoped that if the application to close the patient list is successful, that this will enable the practice to 'catch up'. The practice feel that the Cromwell Primary Care Centre currently provides an excellent service but feel that the quality of this service would be compromised if the demands increase.

Consultation with neighbouring practices and the LMC

In line with NHS England's policy, consultation has taken place with neighbouring practices, the CCG and the LMC Group Humberside.


Comments received following the consultation:-

Practice	Comments received
Scartho Medical Centre	Feel that if this application to temporarily close the patient list is approved that this will put a lot of pressure on those surgeries whose lists remain open and are therefore unable to support the application on this basis.
Dr Hopper & Partners	Have stated concerns that they will be the only practice with a list open in the building and closure of branch and surgeries local to them has increased demand. The practice are currently two GPs down since June 2015 and have been unable to recruit to these positions, this will only be increased when another GP leaves the practice in September of this year. The practice have already been identified as vulnerable and if the situation does not improve then will have no alternative than to also request a list closure.
LMC Group Humberside	The LMC notes the list size is 2,400 which is high for a single handed GP to manage. The LMC envisages that the costs of extra medical cover would not be viable for a small business unless it was intending to expand and grow. Under the circumstances, and taking into account the general trends in difficulty in recruiting the LMC would support this application. We are aware that this will impact on other neighbouring practices and we see a future escalation of application s to close lists


