PURPOSE OF REPORT:	In October 2018, the CCG were approached by Dr Kumar and Beacon Medical Practice to discuss the merger options between their two surgeries.

Dr AP Kumar and Beacon Medical Practice proposed merger of PMS Contracts from 1st April 2019

Application

The CCG have received an initial expression of interest from the above two surgeries to merge their PMS contracts as from 1st April 2019. A copy of the practice report/plan is attached which explains the detail of the proposal.

Practice details

The proposed merger brings together two practices, Dr AP Kumar from Stirling Medical Centre and Beacon Medical Practice who operates from Cleethorpes Primary Care Centre. The merged practice will mean a combined list size of 15,975. There are no plans to close either surgery.

Benefits of the merger

These are detailed within the practice report but a flavour is given below:

- Like minded Professionals being able to work together positively for the benefit of all patients.
- Economies of scale both at a clinical and administrative level. Additional Clinicians will be more able to provide cover and deal with emergency pressures.
- The patients from Dr Kumar's practice will benefit from access to a greater range of services.

Stakeholder Consultation

The practices are developing a comprehensive programme of engagement and consultation with patients affected by the merger and other key stakeholders. This will be shared and agreed with the CCG prior to the engagement commencing.

Health Overview & Scrutiny Committee

A paper will also be submitted for information to the North East Lincolnshire Health Overview & Scrutiny Committee.

Recommendation

The Primary Care Commissioning Committee are asked to consider this request and it is recommended that this is approved in principle allowing the consultation and further work to take place, with a further paper to be presented to the Committee early in the new year.
